IGES for Graphite v9

IGES import and export are being added back in to Graphite v9 SP1 anticipated in July. The IGES code from Vellum 2.7 has been modernized and ported forward to Graphite v9.





Way back last century, when our then Japanese distributor, Famotik, and their programming company, Armonicos, provided development on Vellum 3.0 and 4.0 they took our 2.7 source code and added surfaces to the IGES import and export. In the 2010 lawsuit, the Japanese judge, in an effort to allow their countrymen to save face, ruled that since Ashlar could not prove that the wire transfer payment, sent specifically for IGES, had actually been received by Armonicos, the IGES code updates for Vellum 3.0 and 4.0 must be removed from Graphite.

The updated IGES import for Graphite v9 will import and export wireframe and text. Since Graphite no longer does surfaces this is not an issue. Any surfaces within an IGES file imported into Graphite are simply ignored.

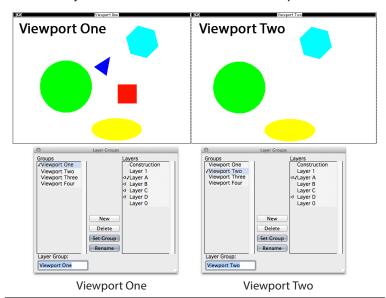


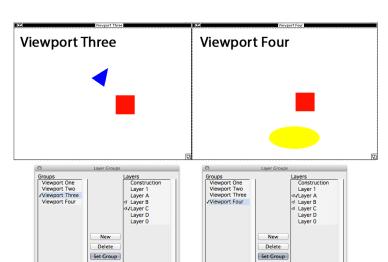
